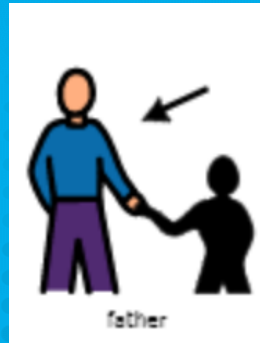

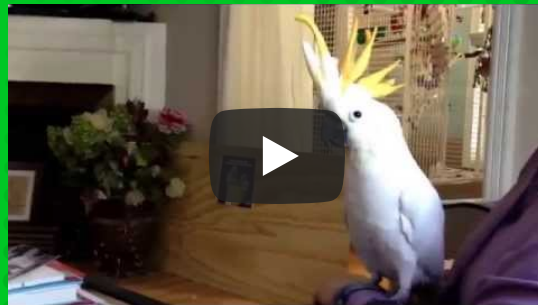


I GO TO A SPECIAL PLACE CALLED A FOREST WITH MY FATHER ON OUR BOAT.

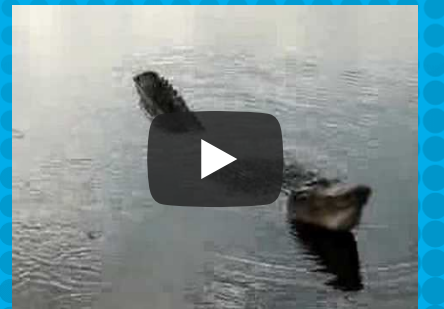

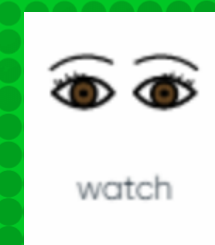
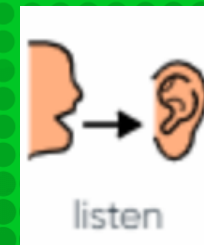
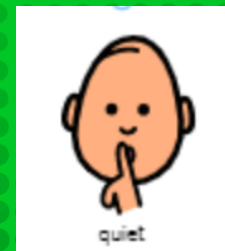


I FOLLOW THE CREEK INTO THE RAIN FOREST WHERE THERE USED TO BE CROCODILES AND KANGAROOS.

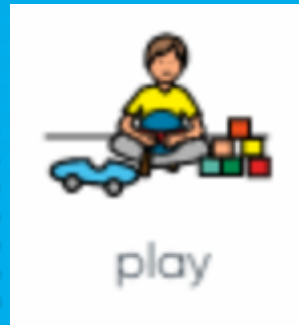


IN THE RAIN FOREST THE VINES AND CREEPERS ARE THICK AND IT'S HARD TO WALK THROUGH BUT I  
BREAK THROUGH.

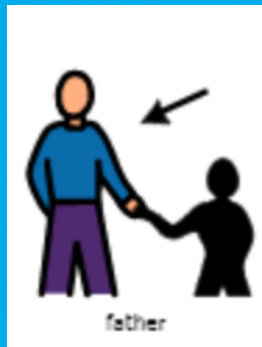
IT'S VERY STILL AND QUIET HERE AND I WATCH AND LISTEN.

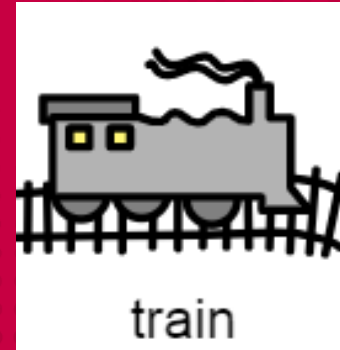


