



**Subject:** History – World War I

**Activity:** WWI Pictures – Cutting Skills

**Learning Intention:** To recognise images from World War I.

**Teaching Strategies (differentiation of activity):**

1. All students will cut out the WWI pictures with full physical support.
2. Most students will cut out the WWI pictures with partial physical support.
3. Some students will independently cut out the WWI pictures.

**Description of activity:**

Students will need scissors and glue to complete this activity. Firstly, have the student cut out the different shapes with pictures relating to World War I. Once the shapes are all cut out, arrange them and glue them on a separate sheet of paper.

You can take photos of students engaging in these activities and share with their teacher. You can also keep any work samples in a scrap book or display folder.

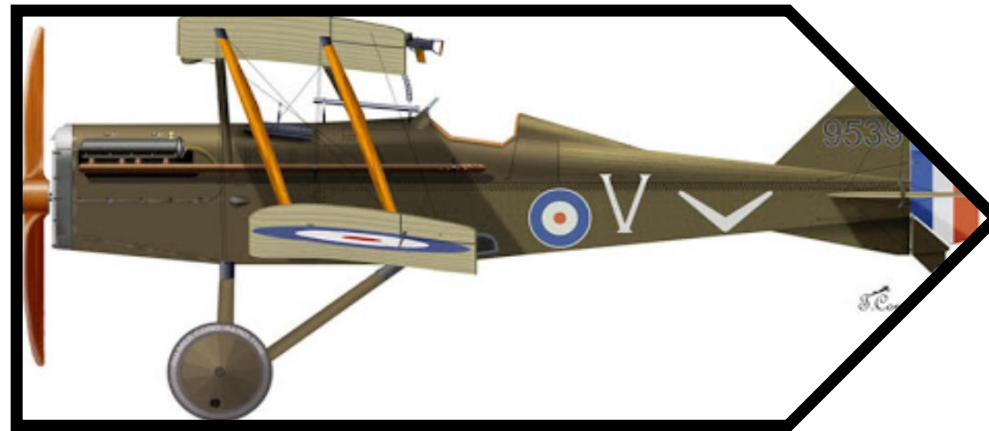

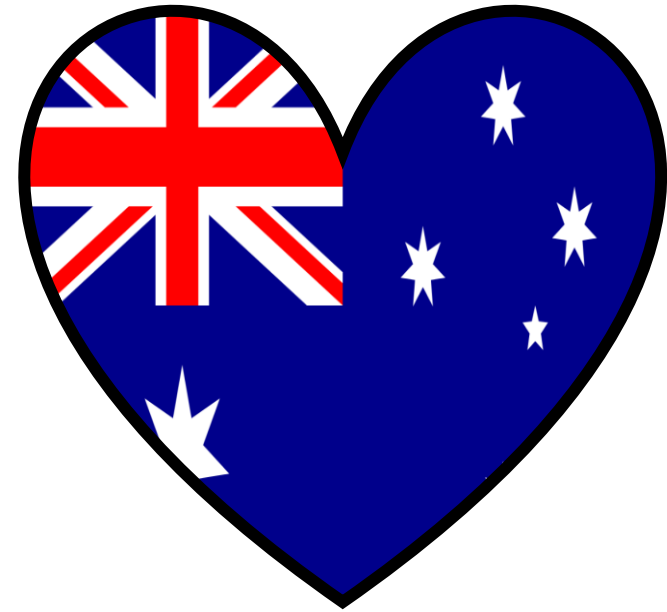
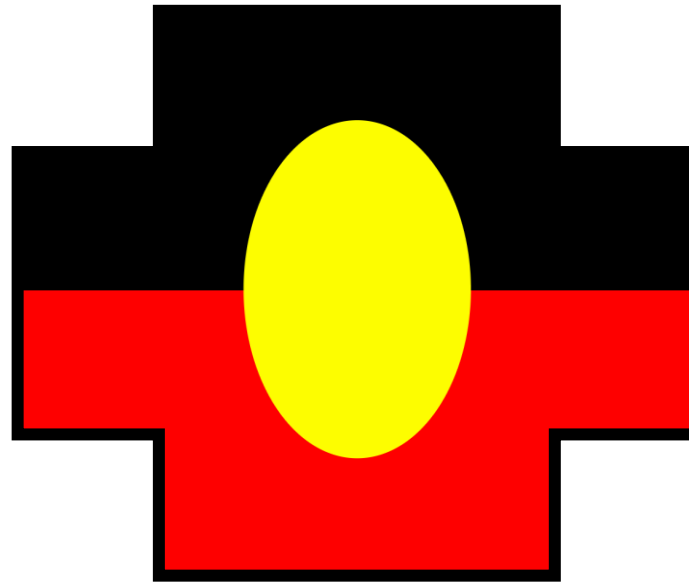
